MPLA/NDLA/SDLA 2000 Tri-Conference Programming

Following the Government Documents Section business meeting at the MPLA/Arizona Library Association Conference in Phoenix, December 7, 2001, two program ideas are being developed and presenters have accepted invitations to the conference. If accepted by the conference planning committee, "Census 2000 Socio-Economic Data" (tentative title) would be the theme for a half day Preconference presented by Jerry O'Donnell of the U.S. Census Bureau Regional Office in Denver. "Mapping the Continent" (tentative title) would focus on maps of the westward expansion found in the U.S. Congressional Serial Set, presented by Donna Koepp, Map Librarian, University of Kansas. This program may be co-sponsored by the MPLA Academic Section. Ms. Koepp was a presenter at the Preconference on the information found in the U.S. Congressional Serial Set at the American Library Association Annual Conference in July 2001. Other possible complimentary programs are being explored.
