The Program Council met at the Campbell County Public Library in Gillette, Wyoming, on 25 January, 2005.

In response to suggestions made at the CAL/MPLA Joint Meeting in October, 2004, PASC Section Chair Kevin Anderson presented the following potential programs for the 2005 WLA/MPLA Joint Conference in Jackson, to be sponsored by the section:

- (1) National Museum of Wildlife Art.
- (2) Jackson Hole Historical Society and Museum.

Two additional possibilities were also presented:

- (1) Historical Tour of Yellowstone National Park, to be sponsored by the Government Documents Sections of MPLA and WLA, and to be co-sponsored by the PASC section.
- (2) "All Things Digital," a series of presentations and/or panel discussions modeled after the 1998 "All Things Wyoming" presentation that was held in Jackson. This would be co-sponsored by the Government Documents Sections of MPLA and WLA.

All four ideas have been formally submitted for consideration using the Meeting Proposal Form. Details on each possible program will be worked out in association with ideas and input from the section membership, after receiving an indication of which program idea (or ideas) might be approved.

Robert Russell, Electronic Resources Coordinator at Northern State University in Aberdeen, South Dakota, has offered his assistance for anything regarding the fall program.
