

Arizona Board Report

- AzLA President-Elect, Nancy Ledeboer, hosted the annual Planning Meeting at the Tempe Public Library on May 21, to determine top goals and priorities for Arizona in 2011.
- The Arizona State Library, Archives and Public Records has received a \$314,790 federal grant to continue efforts to digitize and preserve historic newspapers.
- In July Arizona was awarded \$1.6 million grant with an additional \$706,000 applicant-provided match to expand computer centers at 28 state and tribal libraries and to provide specialized virtual workforce workstations at 200 locations throughout the state.
- As of July, the court transcripts from the 1881 Coroner's Inquest into the Gunfight at the OK Corral are now viewable online. They were given to the Arizona State Library, which digitized them and posted copies on its Arizona Memory Project website.
- The deadline to submit nominations for AzLA Service Awards is July 30, 2010
- 2010 AzLA Annual Conference will be held November 15 – 17, 2010 at the Radisson Fort McDowell in Scottsdale, AZ.
